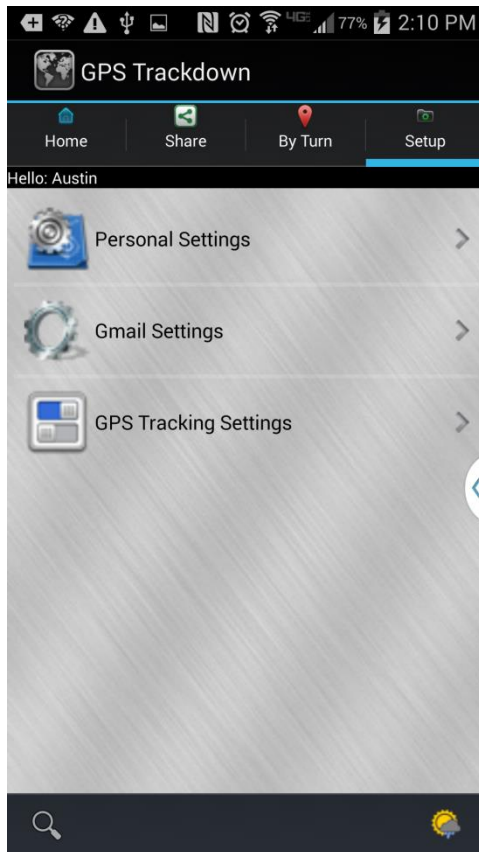


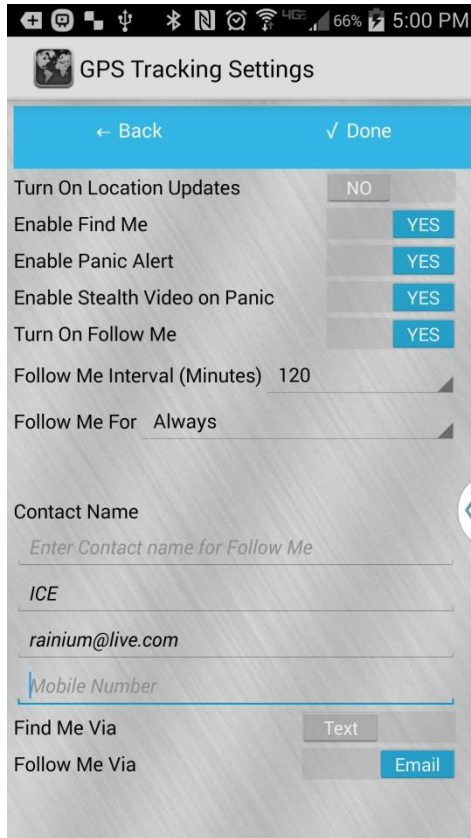
GPS Trackdown for Android

Helpful Hints – What is Stealth Video on Panic Alert?

1. **Panic Alert** will allow you to “hit the panic button”. In an emergency, you may need to have your current location sent to a contact without making it obvious that you’re using your phone. You can also have your phone record a **Stealth Video** after the Panic Alert is sent. Your phone will record a video for up to 10 minutes and store the output locally. If your Panic Alert is sent to Email, the video will also be sent to the same Email address. With **Stealth Video** enabled, only you will know that recording is taking place. *Stealth Video can provide the video evidence that you may need in an emergency!*
2. Select the **Setup** tab and choose **GPS Tracking Settings**.



3. Set **Enable Panic Alert** to **Yes** and **Enable Stealth Video on Panic** to **Yes** . Set **Follow Me Via** to **Email**. Select **Done** to save your changes



4. **Panic Alert** can be triggered from the **Menu** by choosing **Send Panic Alert** or by you pressing your phone's "Volume Up" or "Volume Down" key ten consecutive times in ten seconds. GPS Trackdown will send your current location to your ICE contact. If Share By email is selected, your location history will also be included. *Discuss Panic Alert with your ICE contact and try it out at your convenience. Ensure that you understand the process before you need to use it.*
